**Why Is It Important For You to Enroll in the
Tomah VA Medical Center (VAMC)?**

At the Tomah VAMC you may be entitled to five years of medical/mental healthcare. For women veterans, comprehensive primary healthcare includes gender specific care. Time limited dental benefits are also available. The VA healthcare system provides you with appropriate care and evaluations for specific health care issues that may be related to service in Iraq or Afghanistan such as exposure to depleted uranium, burn pits, and residuals from blast injuries. Ensure you are enrolled in a VA Medical Center (VAMC), provide reliable contact information, and utilize the OEF/OIF/OND Program staff.

What Can OEF/OIF/OND Program Staff Do For You?

OEF/OIF/OND staff members are advocates for veterans and assist veterans with navigating through the VA system. They are trained in screening veterans in order to identify problems and determine resources. OEF/OIF/OND staff members can connect you with treatment resources for medical and/or psychological issues resulting from deployments, an increased OPTEMPO, and unprecedented utilization of Guard and Reserve forces. Your medical care and evaluations at VA Medical Centers and Community-Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC) are critical in determining your VA compensation for conditions connected to your service.
